Senate Momo: EU/S/2024/SP/12: Seeking Recommendation for the Monitoring, Evaluation and the Revision of Curriculum

The Faculty/ Institute/ Department/ Curriculum Development / Review Committee along with the Faculty Quality Assurance Cell/Center for Quality Assurance of the university annually monitors the quality of education provision of the programme through **process indicators**

- 1. student retention,
- 2. progression,
- 3. completion/ graduation rates,
- 4. graduate/student satisfaction with the programme

and outcome indicators

- 1. cost-effectiveness of the programme,
- 2. employability of graduates (Employment records),
- 3. employer feedback surveys report,
- 4. numbers of scholarships/fellowships/internships recipients,
- 5. numbers embarked on/ pursuing postgraduate studies,
- 6. Tracer studies

and uses the findings to periodically update and improve the programme in the light of developing knowledge and practices in the discipline and the quality of education provision, in an agreed cycle.

Therefore, every Faculty/Department/Institute required to submit the above data for each degree programme to CQA at the end of each academic year for the purpose of monitoring, evaluation and revision of the curriculum.
