- vi. Promotion of IT related courses.
- vii. Updating the IT facilities in par with the IT global environment in order to give sufficient knowledge to students and staff to upgrade their career opportunities.
- viii. Carryout any other assignments entrusted by the Vice - Chancellor with regard to the establishment of the Centre.
