Koneswaran, Senior Lecturer in Chemistry at Eastern University, has successfully filed an international patent for his innovative creation: a "pH stabilizing composition for corrosion protection in concrete and method of preparation thereof."

This patent marks a pivotal moment not only for Dr. Koneswaran but also for Eastern University itself, as it proudly claims its place in the realm of intellectual property and innovation. The patented invention, a novel cement admixture, holds the promise of revolutionizing concrete construction by enhancing its durability and longevity.

Dr. Koneswaran's invention addresses a critical need in the construction industry by offering a solution to corrosion-related issues in concrete structures. By stabilizing the pH levels, the patented composition effectively safeguards against corrosion, thereby extending the lifespan of concrete infrastructure.



This milestone underscores Eastern University's commitment to fostering cutting-edge research and nurturing a culture of innovation among its faculty and students. With this patent, Eastern University propels itself onto the global stage, signaling its emergence as a hub of groundbreaking research and technological advancement.

President's Awards for Scientific Research 2023

The General Relativity Research Group of the Eastern University Sri Lanka received President's Awards for Scientific Research - 2023 (i.e., for the years 2019 & 2020 publications) at a ceremony organized by the National Research Council on November 21, 2023, at the Sirimavo Bandaranaike Memorial Exposition Centre, Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall, Colombo 07.

The Awards were given for the best 100 papers published in prestigious journals in each year (2019 and 2020) where a significant contribution had been made by scientists working in Sri Lanka. 
